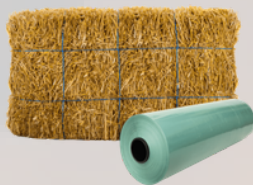

Spring Sowing Seed: Getting Ready for the Season



With spring just around the corner, now is the time to start planning your forage and pasture sowing program. Choosing the right variety and preparing paddocks correctly will help set your crops up for strong establishment and good production through the warmer months.

GrowMax Forage Brassica

GrowMax Forage Brassica is a mid-maturity rape offering excellent-quality forage, with good regrowth potential. It is well suited to grazing by both sheep and cattle. When planning your spring sowing, remember that forage brassicas require a minimum soil temperature of 10°C at 9am, measured at 10cm depth for successful establishment. Waiting for the right soil conditions can make a big difference to crop performance. **Sowing Rate: 3 – 5 kg/ha**

Silver Lucernes

Silver Lucernes offer a wide range of dormancies to suit different production systems. Silverland GT5 and Silverosa GT7 – suited to grazing and hay production, with persistence under heavy grazing a key feature. Silverado 9 and SilverSky 11 – higher-dormancy varieties bred with cutting and hay operations in mind. For spring-planted lucerne, paddock preparation is critical. Getting soil fertility, weed control, drainage and seedbed preparation right before sowing will give your lucerne the best opportunity to establish and persist. **Sowing Rate: 6 – 15 kg/ha**

Green Arrow Millet

Green Arrow Millet is a later-maturing option compared with Shirohie Millet, maturing approximately 10–14 days later. It is suitable for grazing, hay or silage production over summer. Like most summer forages, Green Arrow requires a soil temperature of at least 16°C and rising before sowing. It can also be sown alongside summer legumes such as Cow Peas or Lab Lab, depending on your paddock, seasonal conditions and intended use. **Sowing Rate: 3 – 5 kg/ha**

Plan Your Spring Sowing Now

With spring conditions approaching, now is the time to discuss your paddock requirements and seed options. Choosing the right variety and waiting for suitable soil conditions are key to getting your spring forage crop off to the best possible start.

The main difference to be aware of is that TASVAX 5 IN 1 is not a low-volume (LV) dose vaccine. It requires double the dose rate compared with Zoetis Ultravac 5 IN 1.

FEATURES

CLOSTRIDIAL VACCINE for the active immunisation against:

- Pulpy Kidney, Enterotoxaemia
- Blackleg
- Malignant Oedema
- Black Disease, Swelled Head in rams
- Tetanus

Primary course of 2 vaccinations 4-6 weeks apart.
Full protection develops within 14 days from the second dose.

Studies have shown duration of immunity of 12 months is achieved by following the recommended vaccination program. In areas where the risk from c. Novyi type B (Black Disease, Swelled Head rams) is high, seasonal boosters may be required.

IMPORTANT: DOSE RATES

Subcutaneous injection only. **Cattle 4mL per head. Sheep 2mL per head.** Goats 2mL per head. Requires an initial course of 2 injections 4-6 weeks apart followed by an annual booster. Refer to label for information regarding timing of vaccination prior to parturition.
